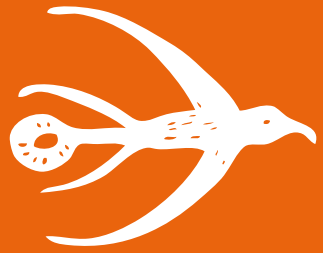

CONCRETE RESULTS ACHIEVED: 1300 people and 12 groups attended the Qabo Mini-dance festival while over 300 people and 6 groups attended the Mini-dance Festival in East Hanahai

- Over 20 planning meetings and workshops held with Enterprise Botswana, 5 syndicates, 2 CBOs and communities
- 1 garden planted with Hoodia
- Governance training for 30 Komku Board members and members of Syndicates
- Partnership established with 3 new syndicates
- Strategic Planning training for Komku 10 board and 2 staff members
- 948 people in 7 settlements reached in needs assessment exercise
- Over 80 medicinal and food plants entered into database.
